



### Institute of Chemistry of Ireland Annual Chemistry Award 2018 (Eva Philbin Lecture Series).

This award, inaugurated in 2005, recognises the significant contribution to chemistry of an individual of international repute, who also has excellent skills in science communication. The 2018 recipient is Professor Anita Maguire from UCC. Prof. Maguire gave her lecture in DIT in November entitled "Using Hazardous Reagents Safely - Go with the Flow". In an animated presentation, she demonstrated that hazardous compounds are best synthesised as intermediates in flowing streams, where they are present only for a short time and present less of a risk. She gave a subsequent talk on 6<sup>th</sup> December in TCD and will also present the talk in the new year in UCC.
